





RETURN TO PRE-COVID HIRING LEVELS

Employers are bracing for a longer crisis than they initially anticipated and are clearly less optimistic than in the previous quarter about the speed of a return to normal.

EMPLOYERS ARE MAKING PLANS TO RETURN FURLOUGHED WORKERS

A large majority of the employers plan to take back those staff that have been on temporary unemployment due to force majeure: 70% of the employers concerned plan to take them back full time, 22% plan to take them back on a part time basis while 8% are considering layoffs for some of them.
